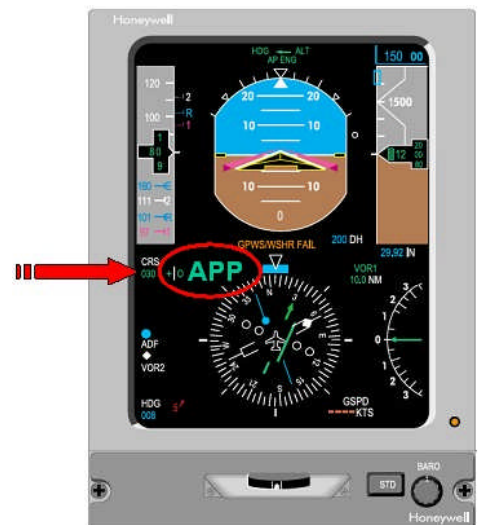

AREAS OF EMPHASIS

The subjects listed below are recommended areas to be familiar with in preparation for a 135.299 Line Check:

- Proper Checklist Used for Pre-Flight
- Checklist Flows / Callouts (refer to current checklist/SOP)
- **Annunciators** (associated lights, limitations, effected systems)
- **Memory Items** (Limitations, Emergency Procedures)
- Pre-Departure Safety Brief
- Proper Procedure for the Rudder Bias Check
- Correct Procedures (if applicable) for Anti-Ice / De-Ice Check
- Proper/Complete Before Takeoff Crew Briefing
- Record Taxi Clearances from ATC
- Identifying “Runway Correct” by PM when on the Runway for Takeoff
- Familiarization with Noise Abatement Takeoff & Approach Procedures
- Sterile Cockpit Below 10,000’
- CRM (Inside/Outside Cockpit, Established FOM Procedures/Requirements)
- Power Setting at Cruise as Listed on Flight Release. *(Normally NCT for Ferry Flights)*
NCT .65 Mach > FL 230
Filed TAS < FL 230
- Approach Profiles
Precision
Non-Precision
- GPS Approach Procedures
Check RAIM ¹
If Applicable: De-Selecting DME on FMZ ²
Flashing “APP” Light on PFD – Prior to FAF
